

Our hygiene concept for courses and telc examinations (November 2021)

Due to the current situation, special regulations must be observed for face-to-face instruction and when conducting examinations.

The following are excluded from attendance classes/examinations:

- People with COVID-19 associated symptoms (e.g. cough, fever, loss of taste, airflow problems).
- Persons with confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection
- Persons under quarantine measures
- Persons who have not been vaccinated or recovered (face-to-face classes)
- Persons who have not been vaccinated, recovered or tested (PCR test) (exams). The PCR test must not be older than 48 hours.

General information:

- An FFP2 mask (no scarf or other mask) must be worn when entering the school, in the office, in the corridors and toilets. This protection must not be removed until one has taken one's seat in the course room. The mouth/nose protection must be brought by each person entering the language school.
- During the examinations, masks are also compulsory at the seat, except for the oral examination.
- After entering the school, hands must be washed or disinfected. Disinfectant is available in the office and in the corridor, and liquid soap and towels rolls in the toilets.
- The minimum distance between participants is not required, due to the 2G / 3G plus regulation, but should be observed as far as possible.
- Only the marked workstations are to be used in the course/examination.
- Pens and other working materials must be brought by each participant.
- The course / examination rooms are to be aired regularly for 10 minutes.
